1. Centre Maintenance

Air Conditioning unit maintenance agreement

The Centre Manager (CM) advised the Finance Committee (FC) of the following (questions arising from the November FC meeting):-

- 1) Check whether the warranty is valid for commercial premises Yes
- 2) What parts are covered under the warranty? Are any excluded?
 - Year 1 all parts and labour including call out charge.
 - Year 2 & 3 indoor wall mounted unit and outdoor unit parts only covered (call out charge/labour to diagnose and fit parts chargeable)
 - Note: the condensate pump, drainage pipework, insulated refrigerant pipework, electrical isolators and cable only have 1 year warranty. After 13 months these parts would be chargeable as well as call out/ labour charge. The contractor advised that it was very rare to see a problem with these parts in the first 3 three as few moving parts.
- Clarify if call out charge applies for the warranty period if annual service is done Yes – the call out charge applies in years 2 and 3 of the warranty period (not year 1)
- 4) Ask for a second quote to maintain the unit from our existing contractor. The CM advised the FC our existing contractor had quoted for a single annual service, however they wouldn't cover any labour costs associated with someone's else's installation.

RESOLVED

The FC agreed to a 1 year contract with Air Improve for £131.

Service to Partition Wall

The CM advised the FC that she had obtained 2 quotes for the servicing of the partition wall. The FC discussed the quotes and approved the quote from ProServicing as they were cheaper and carried out the servicing previously in April 2013.

RESOLVED

The FC approved the quote from ProServicing for £538.

2. External Centre Maintenance

A) Moles

The CM advised the FC that there was a mole problem at Lea Green. She had received a quote for a site visit.

RESOLVED
