Over the last few years, Crookham Village Parish Council has been very busy dealing with the various major planning applications and Appeals that have faced our community. For several years, CVPC members have been working hard to ensure that the major developments granted on appeal are as well integrated into our Parish as possible. Members have also been working with the community to prepare a Neighbourhood Plan which will shape development and growth in our local area until 2032. This work is now drawing to a close and CVPC now wants to engage in other major projects to benefit our community.

Some ideas for possible projects that could be undertaken include:

- **Following on from the Neighbourhood Plan, reassess and update the Crookham Village Conservation Area designation to protect it for the future**
- **Identify major projects within the Parish such as extending the footways along Crondall Road and Redfields Lane**
- **Undertake a programme of work to improve our footpath network**
- **Look for opportunities to extend and improve our cycleways and bridleways**
- **Identify opportunities to use the Lengthsman scheme to tidy up our parish**
- **Publicise Parish walking routes to suit all ages and abilities**
- **Work with organisations such as the Basingstoke Canal Authority to enhance facilities**
- **Implement a programme of parish entertainment and arts activities**
- **Provide new recreational facilities and extend our existing sports and leisure facilities**
- **Create a programme of youth projects**

It's your views that count.**

If you have ideas as to how we can work to make our Parish better and would like to help us achieve our goals, please come and meet us at the Annual Parish Meeting on 8th April.
